



# COVENANTAL AGREEMENT

For becoming a Spiritual Son or Daughter of Bishop Walker

As a spiritual father, it is my responsibility to impart into your life principles, experiences, knowledge, wisdom and leadership. That impartation takes place by hearing the Word of God coming from my life and ministry, into your life and ministry. My responsibility as a spiritual father is not making decisions that you should make under the guidance of the Holy Spirit, nor counseling you for every situation in life.

My job is to impart through the vehicles of conference calls, conferences, preaching engagements, recommended readings and audio/videotapes, periodic times of impartation to the sons and daughters through a yearly retreat, personal phone calls or video conferencing. This is an event where all of my sons and daughters in the ministry gather for days of relaxation, refreshment and hear instruction from the Lord.

The responsibility for receiving impartation is up to the son or daughter. In other words, you have to **come** and get the impartation through the avenues that have been established! This relationship is two-fold.

This covenant should be completed only if you prayerfully believe that God has assigned you as a spiritual son or daughter of Bishop Joseph W. Walker, III and are willing to totally submit to his leadership and guidance.
